Outside of my direct responsibilities, I have continuously remained engaged in professional organizations and contributed to the profession. I have long standing ties to PCACAC, VACRAO, VCAN, and VALHEN. In addition to membership, my leadership roles have included serving PCACAC as the Anne Powell Memorial Mentoring Program Chairperson and Summer Institute Faculty, acting as President of VACRAO, and coordinating member of VALHEN's award winning Hispanic College Institute.

I joined the University of Maryland Eastern Shore as Director of Admissions & Recruitment in August 2019 - a position that came with many challenges but I feel it places me in the right place at the right time to make my biggest impact on higher education. Since joining the UMES team, I have implemented a test optional policy, increased presence and reestablished relationships with communities, and led a trend of increased applications and offers of admission to the University.
